# **PASSAGE**

Matthew 6:5-15

#### **THEME**

**PRAYER** 

#### **NOTES**

- → WHAT PRAYER IS NOT...
  - ◆ <u>A WISH LIST</u> of things that you want to happen
  - ◆ GET OUT OF JAIL FREE CARD
  - ◆ MAGIC GENIE IN A LAMP
- → WHAT PRAYER IS...
  - Communication between a person and a holy God
  - ◆ A <u>TWO-WAY RELATIONSHIP</u> in which a person should not only <u>TALK TO GOD</u>, but also <u>LISTEN TO HIM</u>.

## → WHY SHOULD A PERSON PRAY?

- ◆ <u>A CHRISTIAN'S PRAYER LIFE</u> is what keeps you connected to God and His will and purpose for your life -- <u>PRAYER</u> is the <u>MOST IMPORTANT ACTIVITY IN YOUR LIFE</u>.
- ♦ It <u>SHOWS OUR DEPENDENCE ON GOD</u> rather than <u>YOURSELF</u>...
- ◆ Just as a child would seek <u>HELP -- GUIDANCE -- PROTECTION -- WISDOM -- PROVISION</u> from his father -- it is natural for a <u>CHILD OF GOD</u> to do the same with their <u>HEAVENLY FATHER</u>.

#### V. 5 --

- → Jesus told the disciples -- "<u>WHEN YOU PRAY</u>..." -- He didn't say "<u>IF YOU PRAY</u>..." -- Jesus was telling His disciples that <u>HE EXPECTED THEM TO TALK & LISTEN TO GOD</u> through <u>PRAYER</u>.
- → But Jesus also told them that they were <u>NOT TO PRAY TO DRAW ATTENTION TO THEMSELVES</u> -- all attention needs to be focused on God.

### V. 6 --

→ Then Jesus gives instructions about <u>PREPARING TO PRAY</u> -- <u>FIND A QUIET PLACE</u> away from everyone where there are <u>NO DISTRACTIONS</u> so that you will <u>NOT BE INTERRUPTED</u> when you are talking to your Heavenly Father.

## V. 7 --

- → Jesus is saying DON'T BE SO CONCERNED WITH TRYING TO SAY THE RIGHT THING -- GOD KNOWS YOUR HEART regardless of what comes out of your mouth.
- → Did you know that the Holy Spirit prays to God on your behalf -- Romans 8:26-27
- → JESUS DOES NOT DISCOURAGE PUBLIC PRAYER -- He just discourages MEANINGLESS WORDS THAT ARE SAID TO IMPRESS PEOPLE rather than coming from <u>A GENUINE HEART</u> in need of God's help.

## V. 8 --

→ God takes into consideration <u>WHAT IS BEST FOR A PERSON AT THAT MOMENT</u> and in the <u>GRAND SCHEME</u> of things --the answer may be <u>YES</u> -- <u>NO</u> -- or <u>NOT RIGHT NOW</u>.

## V. 9 --

→ This is called the MODEL PRAYER or LORD'S PRAYER -- it does NOT include everything we are to pray for -- but it is an example to follow for prayer.

#### V. 9 --

- → Jesus uses the term <u>FATHER</u> when addressing God in prayer because <u>IT IS A PERSONAL TERM</u> -- it helps you remember that <u>YOUR HEAVENLY FATHER WANTS WHAT IS BEST FOR YOU</u> -- He sees the <u>BIG PICTURE</u> & <u>KNOWS WHAT YOU NEED IN THAT MOMENT</u>.
- → Honoring God's name as <u>HOLY</u> should remind you to <u>TAKE A POSTURE OF REVERENCE & HUMILITY</u>

  <u>WHEN APPROACHING GOD IN PRAYER</u> -- not come to God <u>IRREVERENTLY</u> -- come to God with the awe and respect that He deserves!
- → Hebrews 5:7

#### V. 10 --

→ Ask God to <u>GROW HIS KINGDOM THROUGHOUT THE EARTH</u> and <u>USE YOU IN DOING SO</u> as Jesus commands us in ACTS 1:8 and MATTHEW 28:19-20.

- → Ask God for <u>HIS WILL TO BE DONE IN YOUR LIFE & ON EARTH</u> -- His will is <u>PERFECT</u> -- He has a <u>PERFECT PLAN</u> -- He has <u>PERFECT TIMING</u> -- and He <u>KNOWS WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE</u> to accomplish it.
- → Isaiah 55:8-9
- → 1.John 5:14-15

### V. 11 --

- → Daily bread represents <u>OUR DAILY NEEDS FOR EACH DAY</u> -- God already knows what we need <u>PHYSICALLY</u> -- <u>SPIRITUALLY</u> -- <u>EMOTIONALLY</u>.
- → You must acknowledge God as <u>SUSTAINER & PROVIDER</u> -- we deceive ourselves if we think <u>WE CAN PROVIDE FOR OUR OWN NEEDS</u> -- we must <u>TRUST THAT GOD WILL PROVIDE DAILY</u> what we need.

#### V. 12, 14-15 --

- → If you are a born-again believer <u>YOUR SINS ARE ALREADY FORGIVEN</u> -- <u>PAST</u> -- <u>PRESENT</u> -- & <u>FUTURE</u> -- but this is a reminder that you must <u>DAILY CONFESS SIN IN HUMILITY</u> knowing that you are forgiven.
- → FORGIVING SOMEONE and forgetting the wrong BRINGS YOU PEACE and RESTORES JOY TO YOUR LIFE -- it GIVES YOU YOUR LIFE BACK!
- → <u>JESUS SAID</u> -- if you forgive, God will forgive you -- if you don't forgive, God will <u>NOT</u> forgive you.

#### V. 13 --

- → When we are tempted God PROMISES that HE WILL PROVIDE A WAY OUT -- but <u>WE MUST CHOOSE</u> <u>HIS WAY OUT</u>.
- → 1 Corinthians 10:13

## A FEW PRACTICAL TIPS FOR PRAYING

- → WHERE IS THE BEST PLACE PRAY?
  - Find a QUIET PLACE WITHOUT DISTRACTIONS.
- → WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO PRAY?
  - FIND THE TIME YOU ARE MOST ALERT and put that time with God ON YOUR SCHEDULE
  - ◆ You may say -- "My schedule is way too busy to find time to pray." -- you make time in your schedule FOR WHAT IS IMPORTANT -- if HAVING AN INTIMATE RELATIONSHIP WITH YOUR HEAVENLY FATHER is important to you -- you'll make time to spend with Him -- IF IT'S NOT IMPORTANT -- then you won't.

## → WHAT IS THE BEST WAY TO PRAY?

◆ Have a PLAN

### Start with a <u>PRAYER LIST</u>

- Detailed list of <u>FAMILY MEMBERS</u> (spouse & kids) -- <u>FRIENDS</u> -- <u>CO-WORKERS</u> --<u>NEIGHBORS</u> -- <u>CHURCH</u> -- along with <u>SPECIFIC THINGS</u> you need to pray for on their behalf.
- Ensures you do not neglect what is important to you
- Pray for people you promise to pray for
- Keeps track of answered prayers

### **METHODS**

- → ACTS -- Adoration -- Confession -- Thanksgiving -- Supplication
- → **SMTWTFS** -- take your list and divide it into separate days

### **HOW SHOULD YOU PRAY?**

- → Ephesians 6:18 -- IN THE SPIRIT
- → 1 Thessalonians 5:17 -- CONSTANTLY
- → Philippians 4:6 -- WITH THANKSGIVING
